Darwinian evolution took many hits this year. Eugene Koonin slaughtered Neo-Darwinian evolution in his article on the impact of genomics, “Darwinian evolution in the light of genomics”, *Nucleic Acids Research*, 2009, 37(4), 1011-1034. Five

years ago, articles like his would never be published, but the evidence from the study of DNA is so overwhelming that professional articles falsifying Darwinian evolution are almost common at this point.

There is much crossbedding in sand dunes and the Coconino. This is the major generalized argument used by evolutionists. But, there is also much crossbedding in underwater sand waves. Sand granules are pitted in a certain way when blown by air. The Coconino sand has the same pitted appearance as sand in modern sand dunes. Research has shown that water transport may follow the pitting so we don't know if wind transport was the final method of movement. Also, it has been found that the cementing process itself causes the same pitting appearance as wind-caused pitting. In 1990, old earth geologist Glen Visher of the Univ. of Tulsa published research he had done on the angle of the crossbedding in the Coconino. The slope of crossbedding in sand dunes is primarily well over 25° with slopes up to 34°. Sand waves are generally around 25°. The Coconino slopes are primarily around 25°. One of the reasons Visher concluded that the Coconino was deposited as underwater sand waves is the abundance of <i>parting laminations</i> in the Coconino. They are never found in dunes because they are caused by bursts of velocity in water flow as it deposits sand. The reason that modern sand dunes have some slopes up to 34° is because the sand will build up and then tumble down a slope, increasing the degree of the slope. No avalanche slopes have been observed in sand waves nor are they observed in the Coconino. As published in <i>Geology Today</i>, experiments were performed using reptiles and amphibians in order to analyze the footprints found in the Coconino. Experiments revealed that the tracks show the creatures that left tracks in the Coconino were moving in one direction with feet turned to fight a current of water, like these tracks at the right. This is a feature of fossil animal track in all layers of the strata, not just the Coconino. When animals (& reptiles, etc) move, they tend to meander. Their path is <i>not</i> in a straight line, yet fossil tracks are almost always in a straight line. Animals move in a straight line when they are running from something, like a wall of mud rapidly moving toward them, 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not diagnostic. CONCLUSIONS:

We will never know for sure if the Coconino was deposited over millions of years by wind or a few days by moving water in Noah's Flood. But the evolutionist has only causal observation to support their argument while the creationist has detailed research that contradicts evolutionists while supporting the creationists. Here is some trivia: The most popular evolutionist explanation for the source of the thousands of cubic miles of sand in the Coconino is that rivers transported the sand from the Appalachian Mountains in the eastern USA to north of where the Coconino is now and then wind blew the sand in place. They see this as possible because they also believe the Appalachians were once higher than the Himalayan Mountains.

prime example. Now look at the pretty colors in the bar on the bottom strip. The bar shows where the DNA of the chimp is similar to human DNA. But **NONE** of it comes from the chimp Y chromosome. The computer software that finds areas of similarity looks at the entire chimp genome to find similar sequences. Each of

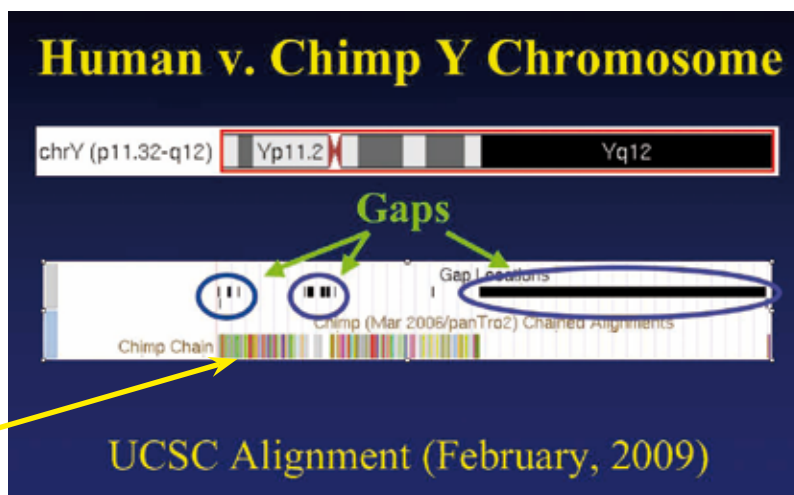
